

SPECIAL MEETING, TOWN COUNCIL, TOWN HALL
WEDNESDAY MAY 24, 2017

A Special Meeting of Oxford Town Council was held on the above date at 6:00. Mayor Stewart presided with Councillors Adshade, Thompson, Colborne and Kay in attendance.

New Business

8.1 CJSMA Board Structure, IMA, Cell and Budget

It was Moved Councillor Adshade, seconded Councillor Kay that Council approve the 2017-18 budget for the Cumberland Joint Services Management Authority as presented.

It was Moved Councillor Adshade, seconded Councillor Kay that Council approve for immediate implementation, the changes to the CJSMA inter-Municipal Services Agreement included in the attached document: Amendment to Inter-Municipal Services Agreement Cumberland Joint Services Management Authority.

It was Moved Councillor Colborne, seconded Councillor Thompson that Council resolve to direct the CAO to initiate a review of the CJSMA inter-Municipal Services Agreement with his counterparts in the other municipalities participating in the Cumberland Joint Services Management Authority over the next 12 months. The scope of the review should include a modernization of the agreement, the negotiation of a dispute resolution mechanism, an emergency budget provision for the CJSMA, and a provision for the automatic renegotiation of the agreement should participation change. Council also resolves to reaffirm the fact that the CAO or a designate is entitled to attend all Board meetings as a non-voting member and participate in discussions.

It was Moved Councillor Colborne, seconded Councillor Thompson that Council approve the construction of a new cell at the Cumberland Central Landfill, contingent upon the amendments to the Inter Municipal Agreement being approved by the Councils of the Town of Oxford and the County of Cumberland.

8.2 Tender 2017-02 - Loader

Council was advised on the estimated costs to rent a Backhoe through Delivery. Based on the report to Council, it was Moved Councillor Adshade, seconded Councillor Kay that Council award to Fort Equipment for a new JCB Backhoe in the amount of \$104,176.

8.3 RCMP Study

An email was circulated with respect to a broader RCMP Study that the Department of Justice will be undertaking for all of Cumberland County. While the recent Oxford Study indicated that a reduction could happen, Cumberland County would need to pick up the Officer we shed. The Broader Study would look at the feasibility of making reductions over the entire County.

It was Moved Councillor Adshade, seconded Councillor Thompson that we request the results of the Oxford Study, no later than June 15, 2017. Council will then consider participating in the broader Cumberland Study.
